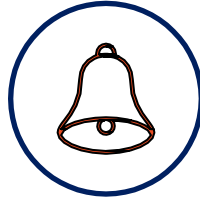
The CoC is currently undergoing a governance restructuring process that includes recruiting a newly established and independent board as well as a community-wide calling for new general members.
