CSAH is the CoC collaborative applicant for GA-507 (Savannah-Chatham County). Eligible Renewal projects are listed below. CSAH is also accepting proposals from agencies that have not been previously funded or that are not currently funded and wish to apply for funding as outlined below.

HUD suggests that applicants submit at least 48 hours in advance to avoid technical difficulties, etc.

HUD FUNDING PROCESS FY2021

- GA-507 COC ESTIMATED ANNUAL RENEWAL DEMAND (ARD)- **\$3,413,274**

- 100% of TIER 1 PROJECTS TOTALS-**\$3,413,274**
 - COC BONUS PROJECT-**\$170,664**
 - DV-**\$339,093**
 - COC PLANNING-**\$102,398**
- **RANKING PROCESS**- As in previous years, the Continuum of Care must rank/prioritize all projects (except CoC Planning projects) in Tier 1 or Tier 2.
 - Tier 1 is **100%** of the ARD (**\$3,413,274**)

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Funding under the NOFO must be through the reallocation process (shifting funds from existing eligible renewal projects to create new projects) or through the CoC bonus or DV bonus projects.

NEW PROJECTS CREATED THROUGH REALLOCATION OR COC BONUS PROJECTS INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

- 1) Permanent Housing-Permanent Supportive Housing projects (**PH-PSH**)
- 2) Permanent Housing-Rapid Rehousing projects (**PH-RRH**)
- 3) Joint transitional housing and permanent housing-rapid rehousing projects (**TH/PH-RRH**)

NEW PROJECTS CREATED THROUGH THE DV BONUS

- 1) Rapid Re-housing and Joint TH/ PH-RRH component projects that are dedicated to serving survivors of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, or stalking.
- 2) Supportive Services Only-Coordinated Entry project to implement policies, procedures, and practices that assists the CoC's coordinated entry system to better meet the needs of survivors of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, or stalking.

EXPANSION PROJECTS

HUD will provide funding for expansion projects to expand existing projects that will increase the number of units, beds or services dedicated to persons eligible to be served with DV Bonus funding.

Interested applicants should read the entire 2021 NOFO to understand the requirements for each project type and applicant and project eligibility requirements. Also, the agency should be able to demonstrate its capacity to carry out the program requirements including experience serving the homeless and managing federal grants. Only non-profit organizations, states, and local governments are eligible to apply. Individuals and for-profit entities can not apply. The entire document can be found below:

If accepted, selected applicants will submit an application in E-snaps. All applications will be prioritized for funding by the CoC Ranking Committee and submitted in the Consolidated application to HUD which will make the final award decision.

COC PROJECT RANKING COMMITTEE

Each project submitted will be ranked by the CoC Ranking committee, a part of the CoC Governance Board and will consist of board members as well as members from the CoC General Membership. None of the agencies or organizations represented by these members will be submitting applications in the competition.

Projects will be ranked using the Project Performance & CoC Priority Scoring Criteria Tool. The tool will be posted to the CoC website and sent to each project applicant.

TIMELINE: The Collaborative Applicant must submit the FY 2021 NOFO application in e-snaps by 8pm Tuesday, November 16, 2021.
